Sub: Submission of Immovable Property Returns (IPRs) by the Civil stream officers of the Posts & Telegraphs Building Works (Group "A") Service for the year 2015 (as on 01.01.2016)

The undersigned is directed to state that according to the provisions under Rule 18 (1) (ii) of the CCS (Conduct) Rules, 1964, "every Government servant belonging to any service or holding any post included in Group 'A' and Group 'B' shall submit an annual return in such form as may be prescribed by the Government in this regard giving full particulars regarding the immovable property inherited by him or owned or acquired by him or held by him on lease or mortgage either in his own name or in the name of any member of his family or in the name of any other person." Accordingly, the IPR for the year 2015 (as on 1.1.2016) is required to be submitted latest by 31.1.2014.

- 2. While furnishing the IPR, it may be ensured that usage of phrases such as 'same as previous year' or 'no change' are **not** used and full particulars of the immovable property inherited/owned/acquired or held are furnished.
- 3. The Department of Posts is requested to obtain, the annual IPR for the year 2015 i.e. as on 1.1.2016, in the prescribed format, from all Group "A" Civil Stream officers of the Posts & Telegraphs Building Works (Group "A") Service working in that Department and forward the same to this Department latest by 31.1.2016.
- 4. In this connection, it may be stated that as per the decision of the Government the 'officers who have not submitted the Annual Immovable Property Returns by the prescribed time, would be denied vigilance clearance and will not considered for empanelment for senior level posts in Government of India'. These instructions may be reiterated to the officers of the Service working in the Department of Posts.
