	42.1 The Frequency Allotment and WOL shall be required from the WPC Wing of the Department of Telecommunications, Ministry of Communications & IT permitting utilization of appropriate frequencies / band for the establishment, maintenance and operation of Wireless elements of the Telecom Service, under specified procedure, instructions, terms and conditions including payment for said allotment and use of spectrum and for grant of WOL prescribed by WPC Wing from time to time. Services offered by the Licensee using the spectrum shall be governed by the terms and conditions of this License.	42.1 The Frequency Assignment shall be required from the WPC Wing of the Department of Telecommunications, Ministry of Communications & IT permitting utilization of appropriate frequencies / band for the establishment, maintenance and operation of Wireless elements of the Telecom Service, under specified procedure, instructions, terms and conditions including payment for said assignment and right to use of spectrum prescribed by WPC Wing from time to time. Services offered by the Licensee using the spectrum shall be governed by the terms and conditions of this License.  42.1.1 The LICENSEE has to obtain, among others, site clearance from the WPC Wing in respect of fixed stations and its antenna mast. For this purpose the LICENSEE shall

42.1.2 The service providers shall install equipment (Base Station) on the site within three/ six months from the date of receipt of SACFA clearance, failing which they will surrender/ get cancelled the clearance.

42.1.3 The LICENSEE shall not cause or allow to cause harmful interference to other authorized users of radio spectrum. For elimination of harmful interference, LICENSEE shall abide by all instructions and orders issued by the Government.

- 2. The above amendment is applicable to only ASPs (Access Service Providers) under Unified License (UL) and the existing Clauses 41 and 42 of the UL will continue to be applicable to services other than the Access Services mentioned in UL.
