As per existing guidelines of Government India. absorption in Central Government will be made only from the Cental or State Governments only. However, the absorption in CCAs some candidates from Autonomous bodies, Corporation, Public Sector Units were also selected. The order of placement in r/o Central, State, Autonomous Bodies, Corporations and PSUs in Seniority list may kindly be furnished.

The seniority is to be fixed as per OM No. 33-75/2011-SEA-III dated 07/03/2014

The OM stated the date from which he/she has been appointed on regular basis to the same or EQUIVALENT GRADE in his/her parent department on one hand and referred Para 4.2.3 on other hand- the Para 4.2.3 states that the seniority is to be fixed as per the length of regular service in the ELIGIBLE GRADE. The order referred in the reply, it was not mentioned order of preference of Central/State/Autonomous/PSU candidates. Hence it is requested to furnish the order of placement Central/State/Autonomous /PSU candidates. Further it is requested to furnish that the EQUIVALENT GRADE AND ELIGILE GRADE BOTH ARE ONE AND SAME. Furnish the eligible grades- and the date they will become equivalent grade as per the above OM and Para 4.2.3.

It is requested to arrange to supply the information at the earliest under RTI Act 2005 as the information sought by me is under the purview of Section 2 (f) of RTI Act 2005 and I requested for the clear guidelines/instructions/advices issued to the CCA units for fixation of seniority in r/o the Senior Accountants/Junior Accountants/LDCs absorbed during 2010 and 2011 in the CCA units of all over India.
