Subject: Amendment in Unified Access Service License (UASL) Agreement for provision of Captive Non-Public Network (CNPB)-regarding.


As per the Condition 5.1 of Chapter-I of UASL Agreement, the Licensor reserves the right to modify at any time the terms and conditions of the License, if in the opinion of the Licensor, it is necessary or expedient to do so in public interest or in the interest of the security of the State or for the proper conduct of the telegraphs. In pursuance of this condition, the Licensor hereby amends/ appends the following in the UASL Agreement:

Scope of the license: 2.10 (i) Licensee may provide Captive Non-Public Network (CNPB) as a service to enterprise(s) by using network resources (such as through network slicing) over its PLMN. (ii) Licensee may establish isolated CNPB for enterprises using IMT spectrum assigned to it for establishing PLMN. While establishing such isolated CNPBs, it will be the responsibility of the Licensee to ensure that the prescribed QoS to their customers through public network is maintained. (iii) In case the Licensee decides to surrender the spectrum, which is being used for CNPBs, it shall give prior notice, at least 6 months before the effective date of surrender of spectrum to its CNPB customers.
