



Madam,

With reference to your above mentioned RTI application, you are informed that there are as many as 70 CPIOs in DoT Public Authority. RTI applications are received either directly or through the nodal officer (RTI) and disposed of by the recipient CPIO. Records relating to the disposal of RTI applications are being maintained by the concerned CPIO individually. The nodal officer collects from various CPIOs only the number of RTI applications received/disposed off every quarter in the format prescribed by CIC and sends it to the O/o CIC after compilation. It is thus clear that no centralized data is being maintained in DoT regarding the latest fifty RTI applications received and replied to etc. In order to have the information in the format prescribed by you., the connected documents from all the 70 CPIOs will have to be collected, scrutinized and compiled. This would disproportionately divert the resources of the Public Authority.

2. As regards para (1) and (3) of your RTI application, on the basis of data available with Nodal Officer (RTI), a statement indicating the total number of RTI applications received/transferred to other Public Authorities/rejected under various Sections of RTI Act,2005 is enclosed. Further details sought by you can not be provided under section 7(9) of the RTI Act, 2005.

3. The appeal, if any, may be preferred before Shri S.C. Sharma, DDG(C&A), Department of Telecommunications, Sanchar Bhawan, 20 Ashoka Road, New Delhi-110001, within 30 days of the receipt of this letter.


