Indiamart Intermesh Limited (plaintiff) has requested MeitY vide email dated 17.04.2025 to block infringing website <https://yoktrqexvdzpwgcln.kesug.com/> as per the order of Hon'ble High Court of Calcutta dated 18-03-2019. The email dated 17.04.2025 from legal@indiamart.com has been annexed along with this letter.

2. Please find attached herewith the aforesaid copy of the order cited in the subject noted above, wherein the Hon'ble High Court of Calcutta has, inter alia, passed ad-interim in terms of the prayer made in the application of the plaintiffs for restraining the defendants and such other websites/entities which are discovered during the course of the proceedings to have been engaging in infringing the Petitioner's exclusive rights, or anyone claiming through, by or under it, from using a mark and/or domain name which is identical or deceptively similar to the registered INDIAMART mark of Petitioner in any manner.

3. In this regard. In particular, attention is invited to the following extracts from the said order:

“(a) An order be passed directing the Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology, Government of India to take appropriate measures to make defunct and take down the links provided by the Petitioner to the Ministry from the World Wide Web and the domain names which are deceptively similar to the trademark of the Petitioner as could be identified by the Petitioner to the Ministry through email address – legal@indiamart.com from time to time.”

4. Accordingly, Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology, Government of India, has been directed to take appropriate measures to make defunct and take down the links provided by the Petitioner to the Ministry from the World Wide Web and the domain names which are deceptively similar to the

trademark of the Petitioner as could be identified by the Petitioner to the Ministry through email address "legal@indiamart.com" from time to time.

5. With regard to the above, it is pertinent that Internet service providers enter into the license agreement and register themselves with DoT. Against this background, DoT is requested to take necessary action to give effect to the Hon'ble High Court's aforesaid order and therefore to block the infringing website as per the request of the plaintiff.

Dear Sir,

We are writing to you on behalf of Indiamart Intermesh Limited in reference to the proceedings of Indiamart Intermesh Ltd. Vs. Ankit & Ors. presently pending before the Hon'ble Calcutta High Court wherein Meity is also party.

As you are aware our Company has been running India's largest online B2B (Business-To-Business) marketplace through a website namely www.indiamart.com for more than two decades. On account of its inherently distinctive nature, the trademark "INDIAMART", has acquired an excellent and enviable reputation over the years. The said trademark is duly registered under various classes and in various forms including a word mark, logo mark, label mark etc. The earliest use of the trademark "INDIAMART" dates back to the year 1996, and the earliest registration to the year 2002 in India. Our Company has full rights over the mark 'INDIAMART' and the use of any identical or deceptively similar mark, particularly in respect of identical services, would amount to trademark infringement.

In the year of 2018, it has come to the Notice of the Company that lot of known and unknown entities/persons were infringing our registered trademarks on the world wide web and in order to safeguard our proprietary and legal rights in the registered trademark, the company filed a suit C.S 78 of 2019 and GA No. 1090 of 2018 before Hon'ble Calcutta High Court with title Indiamart vs Ankit and Ors. The Hon'ble High court recognized the proprietary of our company in relation to its trademark 'INDIAMART' and was pleased to pass an interim order dated May 16,2020, a part of which is as follows:

'An order of injunction restraining the respondents and such other websites / entities which are discovered during the course of the proceedings to have been engaging in infringing the Petitioner's exclusive rights, its owners, partners, proprietors, officers, servants, employees, and all others in capacity of principal or agent acting for and on their behalf, or anyone claiming through, by or under it, from using a mark and/or domain name which is identical or deceptively similar to the registered INDIAMART mark of Petitioner in any manner whatsoever, thereby amounting to passing off.'

Along with the above-mentioned directions, the Hon'ble High Court was also passed an order referring to the Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology (MEITY), which is as under:

"The Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology, Government of India to locate the web portals/sites mentioned in the cause title above and forthwith take appropriate measures to make the said web portals/sites defunct and to take steps to take them down from the World Wide Web, the domain names of which are deceptively similar to the registered trademark of the Petitioner"

A copy of the Order dated May 16, 2018 is annexed hereto. The said interim order was confirmed on September 17, 2018.

For the compliance of the said order, a representative of our Company had a meeting with the officials of the MEITY and forwarded certain links/websites infringing the Trademark of Indiamart. It is pertinent to mention that your office was kind enough to take actions against such links/website provided by the Company but later your office requested us to get a specific direction for MEITY from the Hon'ble High Court in relation thereto.

In light of the above advisory by MEITY, Our Company filed an application GA No. 604 of 2019 in titled

suit Indiamart InterMesh Ltd. Vs. Ankit & Ors. before the Hon'ble Calcutta High Court, wherein the company prayed that:

*"An order be passed directing the Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology, Government of India to take appropriate measures to **make defunct and take down the links provided by the Petitioner to the Ministry from the World Wide Web** and the domain names which are deceptively similar to the trademark of the Petitioner as could be identified by the Petitioner to the Ministry **through email address- legal@indiamart.com** from time to time."*

The Hon'ble Court was pleased to pass the said order on March 18, 2019 in favour of the company in terms of the prayer as above.


We would further like to inform you that the trademark "INDIAMART" has been officially included in the list of Well Known Trademarks. This was confirmed in the Trademark Journal No. 2093 published on February 27, 2023. Now, the trademark "INDIAMART" not only enjoys a substantial reputation and a high degree of recognition among the relevant sections of the public but also provides a higher level of protection against infringement, dilution, or passing off by other parties from using the same or similar trademark for different goods and services.

Therefore, in view of the directions as contained in the annexed order dated March 18, 2019 and in pursuance of the inclusion of "INDIAMART" in the list of Well Known Trademarks, we humbly request you to take appropriate action and/or direct the appropriate agency/ individual to remove/ delete and/or defunct and/or disable the links/websites (appended below) in compliance with the above-mentioned Hon'ble Calcutta High Court order.

Please Note: The operator or owner of the website is cheating the innocent users of the internet hence we request you to take appropriate action at the earliest.

The Court: The plaintiff has filed this suit for alleged infringement of its trademark "INDIAMART". Being prima facie satisfied by the plaintiff's case, an order dated 16th May, 2018 was passed by a learned Judge in terms of prayer (b) and (c) of the notice of motion which read as follows :-

"(b) An order of injunction restraining the Respondents and such other websites / entities which are discovered during the course of the proceedings to have been engaging in infringing the Petitioner's exclusive rights, its owners, partners, proprietors, officers, servants, employees, and all others in capacity of principal or agent acting for and on their behalf, or anyone claiming through, by or under it, from using a mark and/or domain name which is

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identical or deceptively similar to the registered INDIAMART mark of Petitioner in any manner whatsoever, thereby amounting to passing off."

"(e) An order directing the Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology, Government of India to locate the web portals/sites mentioned in the cause title above and forthwith take appropriate measures to make the said web portals/sites defunct and to take steps to take them down from the World Wide Web, the domain names of which are deceptively similar to the registered trademark of the Petitioner."

The said interim order was confirmed and GA 1020 of 2018 was disposed of by an order dated 17th September, 2018.

The present application has been taken out by the plaintiff praying *for*, amongst others, the following order :-

"(a) An order be passed directing the Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology, Government of India to take appropriate measures to make defunct and take down the links provided by the Petitioner to the Ministry from the World Wide Web and the domain names which are deceptively similar to the trademark of the Petitioner as could be identified by the Petitioner to the Ministry through email address - legal@indiamart.com from time to time."

Learned Counsel submits that this has become necessary in view of the report of the Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology, a copy whereof is Annexure-B to the present application. It is submitted that the said Ministry ✓

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has informed the petitioner that without a specific order of Court, necessary measures cannot be taken by the Ministry.

Having heard learned Counsel for the parties, I pass an order in terms of prayer (a) of the application.

No useful purpose will be served by keeping the application pending.

GA 604 of 2019 is, accordingly, disposed of. ✓

Subject: Action requested to be taken by MEITY and Plaintiff for effective removal of content for viewing by public at large within India as per the said orders of Hon'ble Court.

It is observed that a number of orders of Hon'ble Court are issued for blocking of websites every month. There are around more than 2700 ISPs in India and these ISPs are connected among themselves in a mesh network. DOT is instructing each of the ISPs through emails/through its website for blocking of the websites as ordered by the Hon'ble Courts. Ensuring compliance of the orders by each of the ISPs is a time-consuming and complex task especially in view of multiplicity of orders of Hon'ble Courts, multiplicity of websites to be blocked and multiplicity of ISPs.

2. Allocation of Business Rules inter-alia states thus:-

'Policy matters relating to information technology; Electronics; and Internet (all matters other than licensing of Internet Service Provider)'.

3. In view of above and in order to ensure effective removal by content for viewing by public at large, the plaintiff is requested to do a trace route of the web server hosting the said website. In case the web server happens to be in India, the plaintiff may inform the same to Meity who may direct the owner of such web server to stop transmission of content as per IT Act and as directed by the Hon'ble Court so that the content would be blocked from the source itself and the exercise of blocking by 2700 ISPs would not be required.

4. In case such server is located abroad i.e. outside India then access to such URL/website can be blocked through the international internet gateways which are much less in number. This would result in timely and effectively removal of undesirable content for viewing by public at large as is the requirement as per the orders of Hon'ble Court.
