(i) Officers with Thirteen years' of regular Group 'A' posts in the Service out of which at least four years' of regular service should be in Senior Time Scale Level-11 (Rs. 67,700-2,08,700) including the regular service, if any, rendered in the Non-Functional Selection Grade (NFSG) in the Leve-12 (Rs. 78,800-2,09,200); or
