Proceedings

A meeting under the chairmanship of Member (Technology), DoT was held at Sanchar Bhawan on 12th Dec., 2013 for reviewing IPv6 transition across all Central Government Ministries/Departments.

DDG (NT) welcomed all the participants and said that the progress of IPv6 transition of Central Government Ministries/Departments is encouraging as evident from receipt of activity sheets from a majority them. As a next step forward, he stressed upon the need for timely preparation of detailed transition plan of Central Government Ministries/Departments as per guidelines of 'National IPv6 Deployment Roadmap version-II'.

Member (Technology) in his inaugural address said that besides plentiful addresses, IPv6 provides a platform for development of various applications in areas like smart transport & traffic system, smart cities, smart grid, tele-education etc. He added that, in future, the M2M (Machine to Machine) communications will have prime role in human life and IPv6 will act as a facilitator for the same.

Director (NT-II) gave a presentation regarding IPv6 scenario covering the guidelines & timelines of 'National IPv6 Deployment Roadmap Version -II', status of IPv6 readiness of different stakeholders like Service Providers, Government Organisations, End User devices etc. He also briefed about the planned initiatives of DoT like Centre of Innovation, Compendium on IPv6 based solutions/case studies, Certified Trainings, M2M policy formulation etc.

Director (NT-I) gave a presentation regarding 'IPv6 Adoption Milestone' explaining in detail the activities to be carried out by Central Government Ministries/Departments as per the guidelines of 'National IPv6 Deployment Roadmap Version -II'. Although the guidelines & steps for 'IPv6 Adoption Milestone' was sent to the Secretaries of all Central Government Ministries/Departments vide DO letter no. 3-2/2013-NT dated 30.10.2013 from Advisor (Technology), DoT, most of the participants expressed ignorance about it. A copy of the same was provided to all participants for necessary action and apprisal of the senior officers in this regard.

DDG (NT) stressed that all Ministries/Departments should prepare the detailed transition plan as per the timelines therein. He added that the plan will vary from department depending department to on the network complexity and equipment/technological life cycle. On request from some of the participants, it was agreed that NT cell DoT would make available a sample of the transition plan for the benefit of all.

Subsequent to this, the agenda points were discussed and following important points emerged:

- ✓ Providing Link to DoT Website.
- ✓ List of Websites under the respective Ministry/ Departments and their transition status.
- ✓ Workshop/Se minar/Case Study.
- ✓ Any other issue/matter with permission of the Chair.

- Out of 92 Ministries/Departments, activity sheets have been received from 87
 Ministries/Departments. It is pending from Department of Expenditure, Department
 of Financial Services, Department of Health and Family Welfare, Department of Legal
 Affairs and Department of Justice. The concerned Ministries/Departments are
 requested to send the same without further delay.
- 2. On the request from participants regarding IPv6 workshop/seminar, it was assured that NT cell DoT would be pleased to organise the same in their premises on receipt of a formal request in this regard. The logistics etc are to be arranged by the respective Ministries/Departments and the speakers would be arranged by NT Cell.
- 3. IPv6 related information would be regularly updated on website of DoT.
- 4. Many participants asked about consultant appointment for smooth roll out of IPv6. It was clarified that consultants have already been empanelled by DoT & the list is available on the website.
- 5. It was reiterated that the Government organisations should procure IPv6 ready (Dual Stack) ICT equipment. It was clarified that TEC test bed is meant for testing of product/equipment for IPv6 conformity and issues IPv6 Ready Logo Certificates.
- 6. NT cell, DoT has now been expanded and officers have been posted in almost all States/UTs to facilitate IPv6 transition. When the NT cell field units approached the respective units/wings/PSUs of Central Government Ministries/Departments located in the States/UTs, they faced problems about lack of communication from their central headquarters regarding IPv6 transition. The Ministries/Departments need to circulate the DoT IPv6 guidelines to their respective units/wings/PSUs located in the States/UTs. The detail of NT cell field officers is attached in Annexure-II.
- 7. The Ministries/Departments should communicate the details of nodal officers of their respective units/wings/PSUs of Central Government Ministries/Departments located in the States/UTs to NT cell DoT so that the same can be forwarded to NT cell field units to facilitate in IPv6 transition.
- 8. Thereafter Ministries/Departments specific presentation were made by Director(NT-III), Director(NT-III), ADG (NT), Director (NT-CoI), Director(NT-VI) and Director(NTCG-I) on 'Ministry of Urban Development with special focus on Smart City', 'Ministry of Road Transport', 'Ministry of Railways', Ministry of Agriculture with special focus on Smart Irrigation Techniques, Ministry of Civil Aviation and Ministry of Environment and Forest respectively.

The meeting concluded with thanks giving.
