MONTHLY SUMMARY FOR THE CABINET ON IMPORTANT EVENTS OF THE DEPARTMENT OF TELECOMMUNICATIONS FOR THE MONTH OF IUNE, 2023

- A. Important events in DoT HQ for the Month of June, 2023:
- 1. International Relations & Events:
 - i. Bilateral meeting with UK: A bilateral meeting with Ms. Christina Sort1. Acting High Commissioner of United Kingdon to India was held on 38 June 2023 at DoT HQ.  - ii. Visit of UK delegation: A meeting was held between a UK delegation led by Mr. Ellis Gelivir, Head of International Development, Engineering and Physical Sciences Research Council (EPISC), UK Research and Innovation (UKR) and DoT on 21st June 2023 at Sunchar Bhawan, New Delhi. The meeting focused on research and innovation collaboration on Future Telecom between UKRI and DoT. The delegation subsequently visit our premier Research & Development organization in the Telecom space CDOT.
 - iii. ADGSOM-ATRE [Win meeting ADGSOM (ASEAN Digital Senior Officials) Meeting) and ATRC (ASEAN Teleons Regulators Courtil) Joint Working Group (JWG) meeting was held on Zird June 2023. Philippines and India co-chaired the meeting. The meeting reviewed the ongoing status of ADGSOM-ATRC cooperation activities for the 2023 work cycle. India presented the proposals for india-ASEAN Digital work plan 2024 during the meeting.

Telecom Engineering Service (TEC)

- i) TEC organized an interactive session on "Som-Comducts, Security, and Solder Products for Common and MAM, IOF Monder with the Reneit Colling, Product Engineering Hoad at Memia, France, on 19th June, 2023. He emphasized the need of end to end security in 10f domain and the importance of device classification based on risk associated with the application. Session was attended by experts from Industry, officers from DOT in hybrid mode.
- TEC participated as head of Indian delegation in 13th Plenury 6: WG meetings of ISO/IEC |TC 1/SC 41 (Internet of Times and Digital Twin), virtually, held in hybrid mode at Boston, USA, 12-16 June 2023. This meeting was also virtually attended by industry.

Brand Building of India as Telecom Manufacturing and Service Destination under Champion Service Sector Scheme

The 1st meeting of Empowered committee for FY 2023-34 was held or 20 8.021 to consider proposals for participation in 7 National/International events during 2023-24 viz. India-Africa ICT Expo 2023 in Addis Abeba, Ethiopia, Delegation & Buyer-Seiler Meet (BSM) in Atlanta, USA, CHTEX Technology Week 2023 in Dubid. India Mobile Compress (IMC) in New Delhi, Africa Can 225 in Cape Town, South Africa, India Telecom 2024 in New Delhi and Mobile World Congress 2024 in Barcelona, Spain:

4. Meeting with Mo Coal on SG Application and Use Cases for Coal Industry: A VC meeting was held on 1986/022 with My Coal for the review of Opportunity to Design, Develop and Implementation of Pilot SG applications and use cases for coal industry. During the meeting, it was pointed out that proposal for setting up a SG Use case but of LMPDI (Central Mine Planning & Design Institute Limited, an identified Centre of Excellence by Ministry of Coal) is under approval process. A SI member taskforce has been constituted to list cut probable use cases and applications.

5. 5G Taskforce Meeting of Dept of Youth Affairs:

For the adaption of SG use cases, Rajiv Gandhi National Institute of Youth Development (RGNIVD) (a Centre of Excellence identified by Department of Youth affairs) has constituted a SG taskforce with participation from Industry members, Government, Academia members. The taskforce met on 16.06.2023 to identify the possible use cases and funding required.

Adoption of 5G Use cases by Aspirational Districts:

A meeting was held by NITI Aayog on 17.06.2023 for the adoption of 5G Use cases by Aspirational districts and creation of 5G Experience Center. In the presentation, successful deployment of use cases in Health, Education & agriculture domain at Vidisha District (one of the aspirational districts) was discussed.

Status of implementation of 100 5G Use Case Labs:

As amounced in the Budget for the FY 2022-24 regarding implementation of 100 SG Use Case Laba at Academic levisitutions, FCIL has been selected as implementation Agency for the same. Till now, FCIL has received 600 applications from higher educational institutions. As Institute selection committee has been constituted by FCIL which includes member from Dept of Higher Education. The Committee is engaged presently in the process of finalization of Institutes.

TCIL has also received technical bids for the 5G equipment suppliers. For vendor empanelment, a technical evaluation committee has been constituted including experts from CDOT, Academia & Industry. Vendor Selection committee is in the process of finalization of Vendors for PGC (Proof of Concept).

8. Ouality of Service (OoS)

Analysis of Quality of Service (QoS) related parameters mentioned by Telecom Regulatory Authority of India (IRAs) in its report on Tile Indian Telecom Services Performance indicators" for the quarter ending December 2022, was carried out. QoS performance of various Telecom Service Provident (ISDs) were analyzed with respect to various telecome services - relitair service, written service, breaddand service and wireless data service. TSPs were apprised regarding non-compliance of QoS benchmarks and the need for corrective eartien in this regard.

9. M2M/IoT Security and Standards based deployment of M2M/IoT solution

To create awareness among M2M stakeholders regarding relevant Security and Standards based deployment of M2M/IoT solution, a regional workshop was held at Bengaluru or 2nd lune, 2023.

10. Atmanirbhar Bharat-Telecom Products Ecosystem

An Atmantibhar Bhatai-Felecom Products Ecosystem workshop was organized under the Chairmanthy of Sectoraly (Telecom) on had June 2023. The objective of the Workshop was on upgrading Telecom Export Promotion Council (TBPC) into a high-performance organisation that meets the "Make in India, Make for the World" touchtone crieria. Using date-driven analytics, sakeholded for telecom industry deliberated on expected policy changes to achieve the stated objective of the workshop.
