CIRCULAR

Sub.: Provision of Mobile Handsets against Mobile Service connections sanctioned by DOT HQs.

In super session of this office order of even number dated 10.12.2009 and in continuation of this office order No. 03-02/2006-PHP dated 29.9.2009, the JAG and above level officers who purchased their last mobile handset within three years are hereby allowed to purchase a new 3G enabled mobile handset now subject to following condition as a one time measure:


The amount which will be reimbursed shall be arrived at after adjusting the depreciated value of older/earlier purchased handset on straight line method using equated months, from Rs. 10,000/-. This will be effective from 29.9.2009.

Example:

- Purchased previous handset in Rs.6000/- in July, 2007.
- Amount reimbursed in August, 2007 is Rs. 5000/-
- Fresh purchase of 3 G enabled mobile handset in October, 2009 in Rs. 12000/-.

Calculation:

- Time difference between purchase of previous and new handset = 27 Months
- Balance life of old handset=36-27=09 months
- Depreciated value of old handset at the time of purchase of new handset = $5000 \times 9/36 = \text{Rs. } 1250/-$.
- Max amount reimburseable = Rs. 10,000/-
- The amount to be reimbursed = $\text{Rs. } 10,000 - 1,250 = \text{Rs. } 8750/-$
