NOTIFICATION

New Delhi, the 9<sup>th</sup> Sept., 1976.

G.S.R.

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution, the President hereby makes the following rules, namely :-

1. Short title and commencement:-

(1) These rules may be called the Posts and Telegraphs Civil Engineering (Civil Gazetted Officers) Recruitment Rules, 1976.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette:

Provided that in their application to the posts of Assistant Executive Engineer (Civil) and Assistant Engineer (Civil) specified in column 1 of the schedule annexed hereto, they shall be deemed to have come into force on the 21st day of February, 1976.

2. Application:-

These rules shall apply to the posts specified in column 1 of the Schedule aforesaid.

3. Classification of posts and scales of pay:-

The classification of posts and the scales of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in columns 2 and 3 of the said Schedule.

4. Method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications etc:-

The method of recruitment to the said posts, age limit, qualifications and other matters connected therewith shall be as specified in columns 4 to 12 of the said Schedule.

5. Liability to serve in Defence Services or posts in connection with Defence of India:-

Any person appointed to the Service on or after the commencement of these rules, shall, if so required, be liable to serve in any Defence Service or post connected with the Defence of India for a period of not less than four years including the period spent on training, if any :

Provided that such person -

(a) shall not be required to serve as aforesaid after the expiry of ten years from the date of appointment;

(b) shall not ordinarily be required to serve as aforesaid after attaining the age of forty years.
