
Office Memorandum

Subject: Removal of requirement to obtain Wireless Operating License (WOL) for VSATs operating under Commercial Very Small Aperture Terminal - Closed User Group (VSAT CUG) License. -reg.

It has been decided to remove the requirement of WOL for the VSATs operating under a Commercial VSAT CUG License with immediate effect. The license for the Hub/gateway station will be sufficient for the entire system.

2. Hence, the VSAT CUG operators are no longer required to submit periodic deployment data to WPC Wing for endorsement on their Hub/Gateway licenses. SACFA clearance will however continue to apply on the VSATs.

3. The WoL for HUB/gateway stations will continue to be issued as per existing procedure.
