NOTIFICATION

G.S.R.- In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the post of Junior Engineer (Telecom) in the Department of Telecommunications namely: -

1. Short title and commencement. - (1) These Rules may be called the Department of Telecommunications, Telecommunications Engineering Service Group 'B' Non-Gazetted Junior Engineer (Telecom) Posts Recruitment Rules, 2024.
(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the official Gazette.
2. Number of the Posts, Classifications and level in Pay Matrix. - The number of the said post, their classification, and the level in pay matrix attached thereto shall be as specified in column (2) to (4) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.
3. Method of recruitment, age limit and other qualifications etc.. - The method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating to the said posts shall be as specified in columns (5) to (13) of the said Schedule.
4. Service under the Territorial Army. - Persons appointed to the said posts, who has not completed the age of forty years shall if so required, be liable to serve in the Territorial Army subject to the provisions of section 6 A of the Territorial Army Act, 1948 (56 of 1948) and the rules made there under.
5. Liability for Transfer. - Persons appointed to the said posts shall be liable to be transferred anywhere in India.
6. Disqualification. - No person, -
 - (a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living;
or
 - (b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,

shall be eligible for appointment to any of the said posts:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

7. Power to Relax. - Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order, and for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules in respect of any class or category of persons or posts.
8. Savings. - Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, the Other Backward Classes, Ex-Servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.
