Subject: Submission of EMF compliance through Tarang Sanchar /National EMF Portal (NEP) only-reg

This has the reference to this office letter no. 800-15/2010-VAS dated 20.11.2013 & letter no. 800-15/2010-VAS (Pt.) dated 04.02.2021, vide which Licensees have to submit self certification of Base Transceiver Station (BTS) for conformity to Electro Magnetic Field (EMF) exposure norms on following three occasions:

i. At installation- Within 15 days of the 'date of first radiation'.

- ii. At upgrade- Within 15 days of any BTS Upgrade (both by Upgrading Telecom Service Providers and non-upgrading TSPs sharing the site).
- iii. At triennial cycle: Once in three years of all the BTSs whose self-certificate has not been submitted in the three year cycle.
- 2. Tarang Sanchar /National EMF Portal (NEP) is a web portal created for disseminating the information of all BTSs & their EMF exposure compliance status to the public. After launch of Tarang Sanchar portal, the manual submissions of EMF compliances by the licensees had been discontinued with effect from 16.11.2016. At present, Tarang Sanchar Portal is being governed by a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) among DoT, COAI, BSNL, MTNL and M/s Ramboll.
- 3. It has been noticed that some of the licensees have not on-boarded the Tarang Sanchar portal. Accordingly, the undersigned is directed to state that all new as well as existing licensees, who have not on-boarded the Tarang Sanchar Portal, are hereby directed to register on the Tarang Sanchar Portal and submit the EMF compliance through the Tarang Sanchar Portal only.
